SCT Calculations, Team Relay, by Division & Category

The standard course time (SCT) shall be set in accordance with the Team Relay class times as shown in tables 1 &2. A team consisting of at least one (1) large dog shall compete under open division SCT, as if all dogs are in the large team division. A team consisting entirely of small dogs (any combination of medium/mini) shall compete in the small team division and the SCT shall be set for the medium division.
