Requirements:

- Canadian citizen or landed immigrant
- Not an applicant or competitor for the 2022 Team,
- Do not have a member of family, or household, or a dog owned or co-owned applying for or named to Team
- Agree to comply with the AAC Rules and Regulations and adhere to the AAC Code of Conduct
- Agree to maintain confidentiality on Committee deliberations

Responsibilities will include:

- Airline, hotel, rental car cost plus a team uniform for trip to IFCS WAC 2022
- Bye for yourself and a dog to the 2022 AAC National Championships following trip to IFCS.
- Coordinate Committee organized team selection
- Assist with all aspects of preparation for Team travel including flights, rental cars, accommodations, veterinary health requirements, entry forms for event etc.
- Assist with fundraising campaigns and the Financial Coordinator management of income and expenses.
- Assist in designing uniforms and finding sponsorship.
- Work in conjunction with Management Committee and to support the team members.
- While at IFCS WAC event provide support as required including organizing team practices and team dinner, judging disputes and identifying team event selections.
- Responsible for National Team online training program (for April 2022 event) if a Coach is not appointed.
- Monitor, coordinate and communicate IFCS news to the Committee, Team and BOD Liaison that introduce changes to rules, team requirements, entries and performance.
- Assist the team in setting goals for 2022 and the future.

Previous experience, great communication and people skills, a flexible schedule, and bilingualism will also be considered assets.
