

APPLICATION: APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR PRE-QUALIFIER EVENT

To be eligible for entry in the Agility Association of Canada's (AAC) National Championships a dog must have qualified via a Regional Championship. If your dog was unable to enter the assigned Regional Championship, or an alternative Regional Championship, or had to withdraw during the Regionals due to injury or other reason, the owner/handler may apply to attend the limited-entry pre-qualifying event.

Selection criteria for the Pre-Qualifier event is outlined in the AAC National Championship Rules and Guidelines, Section 1.1. <u>National Rules and Guidelines</u>.

To obtain approval to enter the Pre-Qualifier, the applicant should be prepared to provide documentary evidence to fully describe the condition that prevented competing at the Regional event. It is the applicant's responsibility to acquire the required documentation and submit it with their Pre-Qualifier request.
